MSOP STUDENT CAMPAIGNS: FALL 2025

The Memphis School of Preaching students have the privilege of participating in door-knocking evangelistic campaigns. In the Spring of 2025 campaigns were conducted in Missouri and Alabama. Also, recently the students completed their work in three Fall campaigns.

Two of the recent Fall campaigns were conducted in Tennessee. Seven students door-knocked for the Forest Hill church of Christ. This is the congregation whose elders oversee the Memphis School of Preaching. The second campaign in Tennessee was for the Arlington church of Christ where Brandon Tibbits preaches. Sixteen students were sent to Arlington. The third campaign was in Grove, Oklahoma where recent MSOP graduate Juan Jaramillo is the preacher. Twenty students participated in the Oklahoma campaign.

Usually the campaigns coincide with a Gospel meeting. While the one at Forest Hill did not, the

one in Arlington was conducted in conjunction with a Gospel meeting preached by MSOP Dean of Academics, Keith Mosher. Kevin Rutherford preached the Gospel meeting in Grove, Oklahoma. Thousands of homes were reached, some Bible studies were set up, and numerous follow-up contacts were developed. Brandon Tibbits presented good results from Arlington to the School of Evangelism weekly report.

Our next student campaigns will be held in the Fall of 2026. We have a campaign for Pell City, Alabama and one for Pacific, Missouri in the planning stages for that time. We also plan to work with the church in Richmond Hills, Georgia in the Spring of 2027. In-Tune Study

Knowledge alone is not enough. "In-Tune Study" means aligning your heart with God's will so that your life and your message are one. At MSOP, from chapel devotionals to late-night discussions with classmates, every moment tunes your heart to God's voice. You learn that preaching is not about performance—it is about faithfulness. To be in tune is to be genuine, humble, and authentic. It is allowing the Scriptures not only to inform your mind but to shape your spirit. MSOP helps you live what you learn so that your ministry flows naturally from a heart molded by God.

In-Person Study

There is also something powerful about being here in person—face to face, shoulder to shoulder. Online tools are helpful, but nothing replaces the strength of studying alongside brothers who share your calling. At MSOP, you will find mentors who care deeply, classmates who inspire you, and friendships that feel like family. You will pray, study, laugh, and grow together. This fellowship is what makes the school so special—it is more than an education; it is an experience, a brotherhood, a spiritual family preparing to carry the Gospel into the world.
